## I. LEGAL FRAMEWORKS OF BOTH THE ORGANISATIONS:

**Netaji Nagar College for Women**, established in 1986 offering undergraduate courses and programmes to the girls of diverse ethnic origins and multi-linguistic culture and affiliated to the University of Calcutta, represented by its **Principal, Dr. Tapan Kumar Ghosh** hereinafter referred to as the FIRST PARTY (which term or expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context be deemed to mean and include its successor in office, representatives, administrators, and assigns)

**Vidyasagar Metropolitan College**, established in 1961, and offering undergraduate courses and programmes to the students and affiliated to the University of Calcutta, and Government of West Bengal aided college, represented by its **Principal, Dr. Arghya Sarkar** hereinafter referred to as the SECOND PARTY (which term or expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context be deemed to mean and include its successor in office, representatives, administrators, and assigns). Both these organizations will be hereafter referred to as Parties.

## II. PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT

Both the Parties are pleased to enter upon an agreement to establish ties of academic cooperation in order to contribute to the achievement of their overall goals as institutions of higher education through following but not limited to:

1. Joint teaching-learning and internship
2. Collaboration in the area of research, publications, project work, etc.
3. Joint field trip, excursion, and education tour,
4. Joint training, add-on, certificate and vocational courses.
5. Joint extension activities, consultancy.
6. Joint faculty and staff development programmes.
7. Co-hosting and participation in conferences, seminars, symposiums, and workshops, book fairs etc.
8. Collaborative programmes in Capacity building and skills enhancement initiatives like Soft skills, Language and communication skills,
9. Collaborative programmes in Life skills (Yoga, physical fitness, health and hygiene),
10. Collaborative programmes in ICT/computing skills,
11. Collaborative programmes in competitive examinations, career counselling, sports and cultural events,
12. Any other activity that is mutually agreed upon and is beneficial to both.

### III. TERM AND EXPIRATION OF THE AGREEMENT

Any additions, changes, or deletions to this document must be approved by the representatives of both Parties. All notices shall be in writing and shall be directed to these representatives.

### IV. FREE TO EXIT:

Either of the parties will have the liberty to exit the agreement citing reasons for so if the linkage becomes untenable for any reason whatsoever.

### V. NON-FINANCIAL IMPLICATION:

The linkage will not have any financial implication on either college.

### VI. NON-EXCLUSIVITY:

This Agreement is a non-exclusive agreement, and both parties remain free to enter into similar agreements with third parties.

### VII. SPECIAL PROVISIONS

1. Each party will take approval from the other party in writing prior to using the latter's name and logo for the activities hereunder on a case-by-case basis.
2. All parties hereto shall do their utmost to ensure the smooth and efficient implementation of the programs.
3. The parties will consult with each other for any subsequent associated agreement informally and attempt to resolve disputes or misunderstandings that may arise in the administration of this MoU or any subsequent associated agreement informally.


The sanctioned grant in aid of Rs.40,000/- will be released in two installments, i.e.

6. Report : The National Seminar on “The Challenges and Opportunities before India in Contemporary Global Trade Scenario” Organised by Department of Economics Vidyasagar Metropolitan College in collaboration with Netaji Nagar College for Women.
- The objectives of the seminar were to address the research questions like:
- 1) What are the challenges before India in contemporary global trade scenario and the possible avenues to deal those so that trade remain the ‘engine of growth’?
  - 2) How will the trade policies be reshaped so that the conflict between economic growth and environmental degradation can be resolved?
  - 3) What are the reasons for India’s low integration into global value chains, especially in the manufacturing sector and why India has fewer instances of global value chains specific policies which lead to the encouragement of new firms?
  - 4) How governments are facing new regulatory challenges in managing issues arising from digital disruption and ensure that the opportunities and benefits from digital trade can be realized and shared inclusively?
1. The Seminar began with the introductory speech on the theme of the seminar by Dr. Suparna Nandy Pal, Convener of the Seminar and Head of the Department of Economics, Vidyasagar Metropolitan College. In the inaugural session felicitation of the dignitaries who had graced the occasion was conducted by Dr, Bipul De, Head of the Department of Economics, Netaji Nagar College for Women.
- The Honourable dignitaries present were:
- Prof. Rajat Acharyaa, Department of Economics, Jadavpur University
  - Prof. Ranajay Bhattacharya. Head of the Economic Division, Indian Institute of Foreign Trade, Kolkata
  - Prof. Debashis Majumdar, Department of Economics, The Heritage College, Kolkata
  - Dr. Arghya Sarkar, Principal, Vidyasagar Metropolitan College
  - Dr. Anindita Majumdar, Convener, Academic Sub-committee, Netaji Nagar College for Women
- Dr Arghya Sarkar, Principal of Vidyasagar Metropolitan College delivered the Welcome address.
2. The Session -1 was designated for two consecutive invited talks
- The first speaker was Dr. Rajat Acharyaa, Professor, Department of Economics, Jadavpur University. The brief introduction of Professor Rajat Acharyaa was given by Dr. Soma Saha, Joint convener of the seminar and Associate Professor in Economics, Netaji Nagar College for Women. Professor Acharyaa’s topic of presentation was “Trade and Environment”. He explained lucidly and



interestingly the two way causations between international trade and the environment. How lax environmental regulation may lead to “perverse” comparative advantage through under-valuation of the environment, on the one hand; and larger trade shifts pollution load from one country to the other, on the other hand were nicely documented in his presentation with relevant data and evidences. Participants, especially students of different colleges participated enthusiastically in the question answer session on Professor Acharyaa’s insightful presentation. Our second guest speaker was Dr. Ranajay Bhattacharya. Head of the Economic Division, Indian Institute of Foreign Trade, Kolkata. Dr. Suparna Nandy (Pal), convener of the seminar and associate professor in Economics, Vidyasagar Metropolitan College, gave a short introduction on Professor Bhattacharya’s career and achievements. Professor Bhattacharya’s topic of presentation was “Global Value Chains and the Problem of Rules of Origin”. His lucid and insightful lecture was thoroughly enjoyed by each participants which was evident from their active participation in question answer session. The entire question answer session for both the invited lectures was conducted by Dr. Bipul De, convener and associate professor in Economics, Netaji Nagar College for Women.

3. The Post lunch session was for paper presentation by students, scholars and teacher participants of different colleges. This session was chaired by Prof. Debashis Majumdar, Department of Economics, The Heritage College, Kolkata. Dr, Debasish Joddar, joint convener and associate professor in Economics, Vidyasagar Metropolitan College, gave a brief introduction about Dr. Majumdar’s contribution in academics. There were six (6) selected scholarly papers to be presented. The researchers utilized this unique opportunity of presenting their research findings in front of the eminent academicians. Paper presenters got valuable suggestions from our respected chairperson of the session, Dr. Majumdar and other academicians regarding the scope of further improvement and /or expansion of their research papers. The post lunch session was very interactive and thought provoking.

4. The last session was the valedictory session where formal vote of thanks was given by Dr. Bipul De, convener and associate professor in Economics, Netaji Nagar College for Women and certificates were distributed among the paper presenters and participants.

We got excellent feedback from most of the participants regarding relevance of the seminar, arrangement and hospitality.
